



## 2026 EARLY SPRING SKEET LEAGUE

Wednesday nights, (see Sunday Shooting note below) starting February 25th through April 29th. Eight rounds of shooting are to be completed by April 29th. All shooters must be a paid member of Argyle Rod and Gun Club. Prizes will be awarded on May 6th.

Entry fee will be \$20.00 per league entry to be paid at time of sign up.

Shooting cost will be \$5.00 per week/round. You will be allowed to shoot 10 scores. The top 8 scores will be used to determine average score.

Total cost for 10 rounds and league fee will be:  $10 \times \$5.00 = \$50.00$  plus \$20.00 league entry = \$70.00

Shooters must pay league fee at time of sign up. Pay each round prior to shooting each week.

Shooters will be allowed to shoot up to 2 rounds per week. All scores must be scored by another skeet league shooter. **NOTE:** Scores can be shot on Sunday's when club is open for 5 Stand League. Score must be scored by a skeet league shooter rule applies.

Shooters will be able to enter multiple times for different gauge shooting by paying additional league fee of \$20.00. **Sub-gauge handicaps will be as follows: 20 and 28 Gauge 1 bird. 410 Gauge 2 birds.**

Practice rounds can be shot for \$6.00 per round, the regular member cost.

Lewis class prizes will be awarded based on the number of shooter entries. One Lewis class per every 12 entries as follows: 1 – 12 (1 Lewis), 13 – 24 (2 Lewis), 25 - 38 (3 Lewis). Subject to total number of shooters.

Top three places in each Lewis class will be paid as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> Place 50%

2<sup>nd</sup> Place 30%

3<sup>rd</sup> Place 20%

Prize money will be split evenly between each Lewis class.

All Argyle Rod and Gun Club Safety Rules will be followed including shot size and gauge maximum shot weights. 1 1/8 ounce for 12 and 16 GA, 7/8 ounce for 20 GA, 3/4 ounce for 28 GA, 1/2 oz .410 GA maximum weight. **Shell length of 2 3/4 on 12, 16, 20 and 28 gauge, 2 1/2 inch .410.**
